The **JJDP A Title II State Formula Grants Program** supports statewide efforts to implement the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act (JJDP A) and coordinate efforts for compliance, juvenile justice reform and delinquency prevention. Over the last decade, it has been cut 55%.

The **JJDP A Title V Local Delinquency Prevention Grants Program** is the only federal program designed to engage law enforcement and community boards in delinquency prevention at the local level in coordination with a statewide plan. Since 2002, it has been slashed 80% and nearly all has been carved out for non-statutory purposes.

The **Juvenile Accountability Block Grant Program (JABG)** provides juvenile justice practitioners and systems with support for graduated sanctions to address the needs of court-involved youth. Over the last decade, cuts total 88%.
