The Colorado Juvenile Defender Coalition and the Family Support Network are sponsoring the 1st Annual 5K Run/Walk for Juvenile Justice: Keeping Colorado's Children Out of Adult Jails and Prisons. We are joining the movement with 20 other states across the country to bring awareness for children who are sentenced as adults and sent to adult jails and prisons that don't have the capability to handle their needs as children.

Colorado's direct file statute gives prosecutors total authority to decide whether a juvenile should be removed from juvenile court and prosecuted in adult criminal court. Colorado's children have no way to challenge a prosecutor's decision to direct file and risk harsh mandatory sentencing statutes, 23 hour confinement, unable to access educational material and resources needed for a child's development. Because of these harsh conditions two young boys, James Stewart and Robert Borrego took their lives while in solitary confinement in an adult jail. We run in their memory.
